

CHERRY TOMATOES		
Tomato Black Cherry		<p>A perfectly round cherry with classic black tomato flavor, sweet yet rich and complex. Fruit picks clean from the stem and is produced in abundance on vigorous, tall plants. These cherries are irresistibly delicious and a unique addition to the color spectrum of cherry tomatoes now available. 65 days.</p>
Tomato Chocolate Cherry		<p>Deep colour and complex flavour. A really unique Heirloom tomato with incredible flavour and colour. Chocolate cherry produces very deep purple, 1/2oz cherry tomatoes on a large indeterminate plant. 65 days</p>
Tomato Snow White		<p>Medium- large sized cherry tomatoes that ripen to a pale yellow and are nice and sweet. Needs full sun exposure. Height 4-6" and Width of 4-5". 75 days</p>
Tomato Sweet Million		<p>Incredibly long clusters of 1 inch dark red fruit grow on tall, vigorous plants. Indeterminate. 65 days.</p>

Tomato Yellow Pear		1-2 inch fruit. Yellow, pear shaped. Indeterminate, 75-80 days.

Tomato Flamme		Also know as Jaune Flamme, these beautiful orange salad tomatoes are very juicy and have a good, sweet flavor with fruity overtones. Tomatoes weigh 2 to 3 ozs. and are a lovely persimmon orange color both inside and out. Extremely productive heirloom from France. Indeterminate. 70 days.

Tomato Azoychka		This is a delightful small yellow beefsteak tomato that matures so early it will be one of the first varieties to ripen in your garden. Beautifully smooth, lemon yellow fruit weighs about 8 ozs. and is very flavorful, rich but pleasantly sweet with a delicious hint of citrus. 70 days

Tomato Brandywine**

These luscious, ruby-red slicers are the result of a cross of Brandywine and Costoluto Genovese, two of our most delicious heirloom varieties. This fusion produces beautiful, slightly squat, globe-shaped tomatoes with the most delectable flavor. 70-75 days

CANNING/SAUCING TOMATOES

Tomato San Marzano



Excellent for canning, tomato paste, or puree. Rectangular pear-shaped, 3-1/2 inch long fruit with mild flavor and meaty texture. Bright red color. Indeterminate. 80 days.

FUN HEIRLOOM TOMATOES

Tomato Costoluto



Italian heirloom tomatoes. Large, deep-red, juicy tomatoes are deeply ribbed but fully flavored and absolutely delicious. This variety is hearty and does well in hot weather, but continues to produce even when the weather turns cool. Indeterminate. 78 days.

<p>Tomato-Cherokee Purple</p>		<p>Very productive plants bear loads of 10 to 12 oz. dusky rose/purple fruit with deep brick red interiors. The tomatoes are delicious with a pleasantly sweet and rich flavor. With thin skin and soft flesh, the fruit is somewhat perishable, but they taste so good they will be eaten quickly anyhow. 80 days.</p>
<p>Tomato Paul Robeson</p>		<p>One of the most highly regarded black tomatoes, this one features medium sized deep maroon fruits that are free of most blemishes and cracking. Their flavor is complex, sweet yet tangy, and characteristic of that distinctive richness that makes black tomatoes special. Russian heirloom. Indeterminate. 75 days.</p>
<p>Tomato Watermelon Beefsteak</p>		<p>Produces lightly scalloped pink beefsteak tomatoes that weigh one pound or more. Their rich, sweet flavor has a depth and intensity that is just outstanding. Indeterminate. 75 days.</p>
